Twin Lakes Center offers outpatient services in Bedford, Somerset, Ebensburg, Johnstown and Meyersdale. Twin Lakes Center is licensed by the Department of Health, Bureau of Drug and Alcohol Programs. Twin Lakes Center accepts funding from numerous sources including a variety of insurances and Medical Assistance. Twin Lakes Center is a HealthChoices provider. 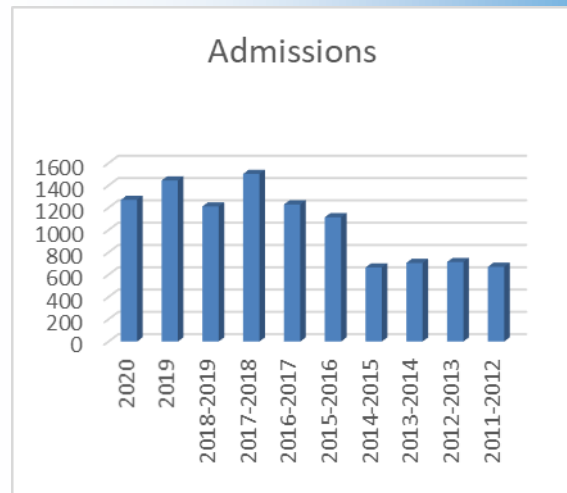

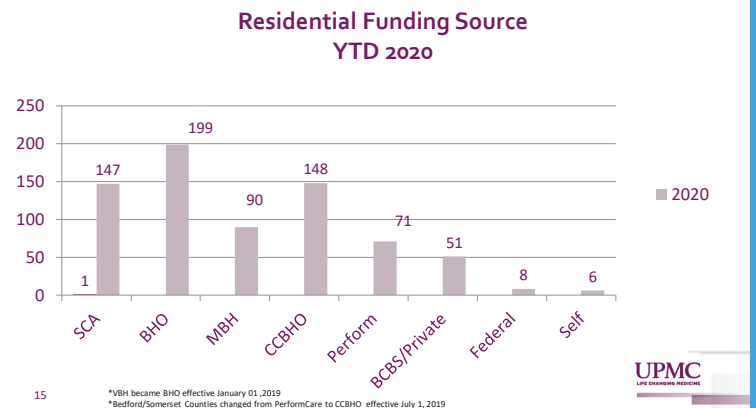

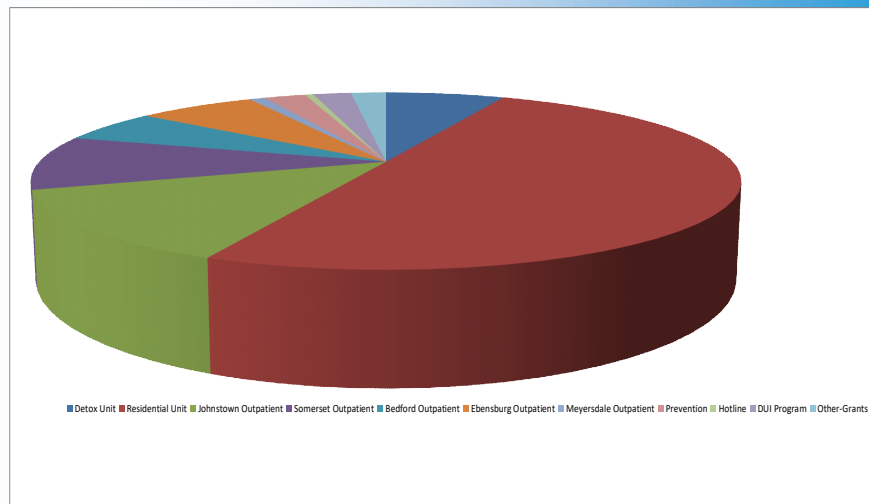
## Detox and Residential Treatment
